## Lack of Brake-Shift Interlock (BSI) Defect

An industry standard since 1990 or earlier, BSI prevents the INADVERTANT and unintentional movement of an automatic transmission from "Park" to non-park. Chrysler management refused to install BSI in it cars, trucks and minivans on the basis that the US Government did not require. All Chrysler vehicles dating from model years 1990 through 2000, involving **15 million units**, continue to pose the threat of injury/death to owners and bystanders because Chrysler has refused to retrofit the defective vehicles or notify the owners of the lack of BSI.

## Jeep Grand Cherokee Fuel System Defect

Fuel tank mounted to the rear of axle causes tank rupture and explosion during real world collisions. No other SUV continues to utilize this defective fuel tank system design/location EXCEPT Chrysler Jeep SUVs. Jeep vehicles dating from model years 1993 through 2004, involving approximately **3 million units**, continue to pose threat of fire death to owners. Chrysler identified a safety fix "Fuel Tank blocker" in 2003 but refused to issue a safety recall notice.
